Spacing and Load Considerations: Maintain support spacing according to tray type and load, typically 1.2–3 meters apart. Ensure the tray load does not exceed the manufacturer's recommended weight, often around 10 kg/m for lightweight fireproof trays.

Fireproofing and Sealing

Firestopping at Penetrations: When trays pass through walls, slabs, or enter electrical panels, seal openings with fire-rated materials such as firestop packs, mineral wool, or firestop mastic. Ensure gaps around cables do not exceed 1 cm² and packing thickness is at least 24 cm.

Backing Plates for Large Openings: For larger penetrations, install a fire-resistant backing plate before sealing to provide structural support and maintain fire integrity.
