

How to connect the dual-fiber optical module interface

Step 3: Insert the Optical Modules Power off the devices if recommended by the manufacturer. Carefully insert the SFP/SFP+ modules into the device ports without forcing them. Ensure the module clicks into place and is seated properly to maintain port integrity ().

Step 4: Connect the Fibers Connect the TX port of the first module to the RX port of the second module, and vice versa. Maintain proper polarity to ensure data flows correctly. Avoid bending the fiber sharply; follow the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer ().

Step 5: Configure the Interfaces Enable the SFP interfaces on your devices. Check auto-negotiation settings if applicable. Verify the link status using commands such as `show interface` or device-specific monitoring tools ().

Step 6: Test the Link Use an optical power meter and light source to measure signal strength and loss. Confirm that the link is active and error-free. For longer distances, ensure the fi...
