

How to connect the fiber optic patch cord end face for surveillance

Secure and Route the Cable: Follow bend-radius rules to prevent excessive stress. Label the patch cords for traceability and future maintenance.

Power On and Test: Turn on the transmitter and receiver, then verify that the camera feed displays correctly on the monitor. Adjust connections if necessary to maintain signal clarity.

- Avoid splicing the fiber unless necessary; use pre-terminated patch cords for simplicity.
