- Inserting the fiber into the ferrule
- Applying UV glue or epoxy
- Curing and polishing the fiber end
- Securing the connector housing ()

Ensure the connector end faces are clean and free of dust before mating.

Step 4: Join the Cables

- Using a Coupler or Adapter:** If both cables have connectors, insert each connector into a fiber optic coupler or adapter. Align carefully to avoid forcing the connection, which can damage the fiber ().
- Using a Splice:** If splicing, align the stripped fiber ends in the splicer, perform the fusion, and protect the splice with a heat-shrink sleeve or splice tray.
