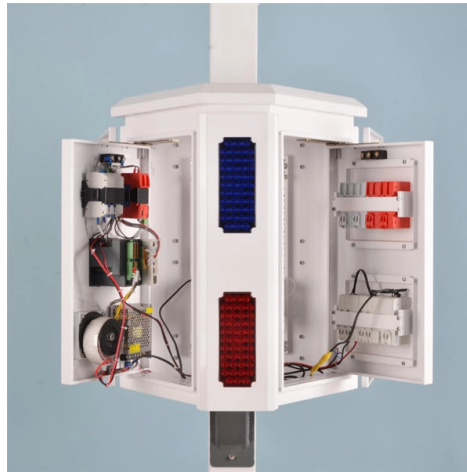


How to disconnect the wiring in the distribution box

Always de-energize the circuit first, verify no voltage is present, then disconnect wires carefully while labeling and capping unused conductors. Safety First Before touching any wiring, turn off the main breaker to de-energize the circuit you plan to work on. Use a voltage tester or multimeter to confirm that no electrical potential exists on the wires inside the distribution box, as residual voltage can be lethal. Wear insulated gloves and safety glasses for additional protection. Identify Terminals Inside the distribution or disconnect box, terminals are typically labeled as Line (incoming power from the main panel) and Load (outgoing wires to appliances or circuits). The Line terminals are usually at the top, while Load terminals are at the bottom. The grounding terminal is often green or bonded to the metal enclosure and connects to the bare or green-insulated grounding wire. Disconnecting Wires Loosen terminal screws on the Line and Load connections using the appropriate screwdriver or wrench. Remove the hot wires (usually black and red for 240V circuits) from the terminals. Disconnect the neutral wire if present, and the grounding wire from the grounding terminal. For fused disconnects, follow the fuse block design to safely remove wires without damaging the fuse holders. Handling Unused Wires If you are disconnecting wires that will not be used immediately: Cap each wire end with a wire nut to prevent accidental contact. Label each wire with its origin or former breaker number for future reference. Do not remove wires from junction boxes unless you can access the entire length safely, as hidden connections may exist inside walls. Final Steps Leave the breaker in the off position if the space will not be reused immediately. Ensure all wires are neatly arranged and secured inside the box. Maintain accessibility to the box; do not cover it unless all wires are completely removed and...
