

How to divide the wires inside the distribution box

- Circuit Breaker Arrangement:** Breakers are usually arranged from left to right, with reserved positions on the right side of the box.
- Wiring Direction:** Wiring from the main breaker to branch breakers generally runs on the left, while outgoing wiring from the box goes to the right.
- Wire Binding:** Wires are tied with plastic ties to keep them straight and organized, ensuring no tangling or obstruction.
- Wire Sizing:** Wire gauge is selected based on circuit load, e.g., 2.5mm² for lighting and sockets, 4mm² for high-load appliances like air conditioners.
- Safety and Marking** Each wire and circuit should be clearly labeled for voltage type (AC/DC) and phase. After wiring, a safety inspection is performed to check for short circuits, overloads, or improper connections. Proper separation and organization of wires in the distribution box not...
