

How to erect a pole for fiber optic cables

Installation Methods Temporary Supports: Install cable supports, chutes, or tangent blocks at each pole along the route (). Pulling the Cable: Thread a pull line through the supports, attach it to the cable with a swivel and grip, and pull the cable into position. Use a non-metallic rope or winch line, monitoring tension to avoid exceeding the maximum rated cable load (). Tensioning and Sag: Once in place, tension the cable to achieve the correct sag, allowing slack for building access or splicing (). Termination: Secure the cable at dead-end poles and intermediate poles using appropriate clamps or hardware (). For figure-8 cables, the messenger component is tensioned at dead-end poles, while intermediate poles support the cable in tangent clamps (). Hardware and Safety Use proper clamps, anchors, and spacers to prevent cable damage. Inspect all equipment and wear safety harnesses when working aloft (). Follow OSHA regulations, National Electrical Safety Code (NESC), and local safety policies (). Ensure pulling winches are calibrated or use a dynamometer to monitor tension ().
