

How to insert a dual-port optical module

- 4. Connect the Fiber Cables**Plug each fiber connector into the corresponding port on the module. Ensure proper orientation: Tx to Rx and Rx to Tx. Avoid touching the fiber ends to prevent contamination. Clean connectors with a fiber cleaning tool if necessary.
- 5. Verify the Connection**Check the port activity LEDs on the device to confirm the link is active. Run diagnostic commands or network monitoring tools to ensure both ports are transmitting and receiving data correctly.
- 6. Safety and Maintenance**Do not look directly into the optical ports, as laser light can be harmful. Reapply dust caps when disconnecting fibers for maintenance.
