

How to install cable tray supports

 - Ceiling Suspension (Trapeze or C-Hangers):** Drill into the ceiling slab, install drop-in anchors, and attach threaded rods. Connect a horizontal Unistrut or trapeze bar to support the tray. Level the strut using nuts and washers.
- 5. Install Supports and Tray Sections** Secure the supports firmly, then align and connect tray sections using couplers or splice plates. Ensure trays are level and straight. For long runs, use rollers to lay cables smoothly and avoid kinks. Cut trays to fit corners or specific lengths, and deburr edges to prevent cable damage.
- 6. Lay and Secure Cables** Organize cables neatly within the tray using ties or straps. Maintain separation by voltage or function, and leave slack for expansion or future adjustments. Ensure...
