

How to install heat shrink tubing on junction boxes

5. Allow Cooling Let the tubing cool slowly before handling or applying stress. This ensures a durable, secure seal and prevents brittleness or cracking .
6. Optional: Soldering Considerations If soldering inside the junction box, position the tubing far enough from the soldering area to prevent premature shrinking. Slide it over the joint after soldering if necessary .
7. Inspect the Installation Check that the tubing is fully contracted, smooth, and free of gaps. Properly installed heat shrink tubing provides insulation, mechanical protection, and a professional finish . Following these steps ensures that your junction box connections are safely insulated and protected from moisture, mechanical stress, and electrical shorts.
