

How to lay non-standard optical cables

Laying non-standard optical cables requires careful handling, adherence to manufacturer specifications, and customized installation techniques to prevent damage and ensure performance.

Preparation and Inspection Before installation, inspect the cable carefully for any shipping damage and verify that the delivered cable matches the order in type, fiber count, and length. Store the cable on-site in a safe, dry location, keeping the reel's plastic wrap intact until installation. Always wear protective gloves and steel-toed boots when handling heavy reels to prevent injury and cable damage.

Handling and Routing Non-standard cables may have unique strength members or jacket materials, so follow the manufacturer's instructions for pulling and bending. Use swivel pulling eyes attached to the cable's strength members (e.g., aramid yarn) to prevent twisting. Never pull the cable by the jacket unless explicitly approved. Lay the cable in a figure-8 pattern on the ground to avoid twists during long pulls.

Tension and Bending Respect the maximum tensile strength and minimum bending radius specified by the manufacturer. Exceeding these limits can cause fiber breaks or signal loss. As a general guideline, the minimum bending radius under load is typically 20 times the cable diameter, and 15 times the diameter when unloaded, but always confirm with the cable datasheet.

Installation Techniques

- Underground:** Use ducts, conduits, or direct burial methods. Ensure slack storage at manholes or handholes for maintenance and splicing. Avoid sharp bends and crushing forces during placement.
- Aerial:** Support the cable with appropriate hardware, maintaining tension limits and avoiding contact with sharp edges.
- Custom or non-standard designs:** Some cables may require special grips, pulling methods, or protective conduits. Always consult the manufacturer for installation-specific recommendations.
