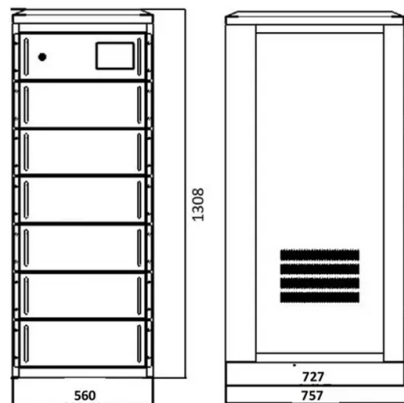


How to patch and connect wires on a fiber optic cable
