

How to plug the fiber optic cable into the panel

Use flexible low-voltage conduit in high-traffic areas to protect the cable from damage. Avoid using plastic zip ties that can crush the cable; instead, secure it with soft Velcro wraps.

Prepare the Panel: Open the patch panel and identify the adapter ports and splice trays. Label each port to match the incoming fiber strands for easy identification.

Protect Connector Ends: If using pre-terminated cables, keep the connector ends in protective boots or wrap them with durable tape during pulling to prevent damage.

Splicing or Plugging: For bulk fiber cables, separate individual strands and either splice them into the splice tray or plug pre-terminated connectors into the adapter ports. Ensure each fiber is correctly matched to its corresponding port to maintain network integrity.

Cable Management: Use the panel's built-in cable management trays to neatly store excess fiber and maintain proper bend radius. Th...
