

How to pull the fiber optic cable reel

Pulling Force: Check the manufacturer's specifications for maximum tensile load. Exceeding this limit can break the internal fibers even if the cable appears intact externally. Use steady, controlled pulling rather than sudden jerks, and avoid overfilling conduits to reduce friction .

Safety and Equipment: Use appropriate personal protective equipment and ensure the reel and stand are stable. For respooling or cutting operations, follow proper traverse travel and speed settings to avoid excessive tension or cable crossovers .
