

How to quickly replace a fiber optic router

Update the router firmware to the latest version to ensure compatibility with fiber speeds and security updates.

Step 5: Optimize Placement Place the router in a central, elevated location to minimize dead zones. Avoid placing it near metal, concrete, or brick structures, and keep it away from other electronic devices that may cause interference.

Step 6: Connect Devices and Test Reconnect your devices to the new Wi-Fi network using the updated SSID and password. Run a speed test to verify that the router is delivering optimal performance. For critical applications like...
