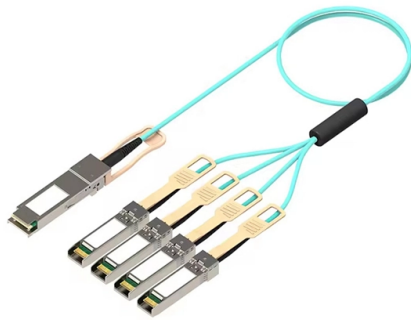


How to use the mobile network s built-in fiber optic router
