An Optical Distribution Network (ODN) is the passive fiber infrastructure that delivers optical signals from a central office to multiple end-users, enabling reliable, cost-effective, and scalable fiber-optic communication.

The ODN is entirely passive, relying on optical fibers, splitters, and protective enclosures to guide and distribute light signals.

Key Components

- Optical Fiber Cables:** These are the physical medium carrying light signals. Modern fibers like G.652D or G.657A2 offer low attenuation and high bend resistance, allowing long-distance transmission with minimal signal loss.
- Optical Splitters:** Passive devices that divide a single optical signal into multiple outputs, supporting the point-to-multipoint topology of PONs. Common split ratios include 1:8, 1:16, 1:32, and 1:64.
- Distribution Frames and Boxes:** Optical Distribution Frames (ODFs) and Fiber Distribution Boxes (FDBs) organize, terminate, and splice fibers, ensuring structured cable management and simplified maintenance.
- Connectors and Closures:** Fiber connectors provide plug-and-play terminations, while splice closures protect fiber splices from environmental damage, humidity, and mechanical stress, maintaining long-term signal integrity.
- Drop Cables and Terminals:** Pre-connectorized drop cables and terminal boxes connect the distribution network to individual homes or businesses, reducing field splicing and labor costs.

Network Design Considerations

- Optical Loss and Power Budget:** Maximum permissible attenuation between OLT and ONT is typically around 28 dB for Class B networks, with split ratios and fiber length carefully planned to maintain signal quality.
