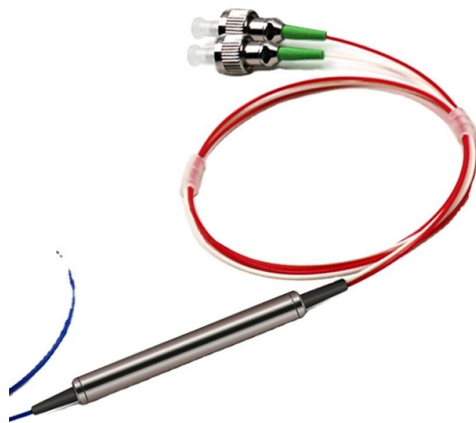

Coordination: SPDs must be coordinated with upstream and downstream circuit breakers (MCBs, RCCBs, or RCBOs) to prevent nuisance tripping and maintain continuous power delivery . Type Selection: Type 2 SPDs are commonly used in household distribution boards as the first line of defense for indoor circuits
