

Installing cable tray threaded rods

Cable trays can be securely installed using threaded rods by following proper support spacing, alignment, and hardware procedures to ensure safety and load compliance.

Preparation and Materials Before installation, inspect all materials including cable trays, ladders, threaded rods, clamps, washers, and nuts to ensure they match approved shop drawings and are free from damage or defects. Store trays horizontally on a flat surface with timber supports at intervals of about 1 meter to prevent warping or moisture damage. Review the approved layout drawings to determine tray routes, bends, branches, and offsets.

Threaded Rod Installation

Mark Support Locations: Identify ceiling or structural points where threaded rods will be anchored. Use appropriate metal plugs or anchors for concrete or masonry ceilings.

Drill and Anchor Rods: Drill holes and fix threaded rods vertically, ensuring they are plumb and aligned with the tray route. Maximum spacing between supports is typically 1.2 meters to prevent sagging.

Attach Support Channels: Fix 'L' angles or slotted 'C' channels to the threaded rods using washers and hex nuts. Ensure the rods pass through the holes in the clamps and that washers are positioned between the nuts and clamp for secure load distribution.

Mounting the Cable Tray

Position Clamps: Place clamps around the tray siderails. For double ladder trays, use double clamps (DC) to support adjacent trays.

Lift and Secure Tray: Lift the tray section so the threaded rod passes through the clamp holes. Place a washer and hex nut below the tray, then adjust the upper nut to secure the tray at the desired elevation.

Alignment and Leveling: Ensure trays are straight and level. Center-hung supports allow easier cable installation from both sides.

Support Bends and Offsets: Provide additional supports at bends, branches, and offsets to maintain structural integrity.

Safety and Compliance Maximum load per hanger is typically 318–340 kg, with support spacing not exceeding 3.6 meters. Use manufacturer-approved fittings and...
