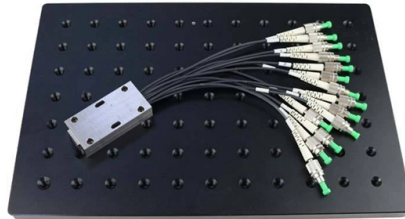


Installing fiber optic cable reels

Proper fiber optic cable reel installation involves careful handling, inspection, and controlled deployment to prevent damage and ensure optimal performance.

Preparation and Inspection Before installation, inspect the cable reel for damage such as broken flanges, nails, or crossovers that could harm the cable during deployment. Ensure the reel bolts are tight and the protective covering remains in place until installation begins. Never lift from the tail-flange side, and avoid rolling or kicking the reel to prevent cable damage.

Deployment Techniques **Figure-8 Method** When unspooling cable on the ground, use a figure-8 loop configuration to prevent twisting. Loop sizes typically range from 2–4 meters for outdoor cables, with larger loops for stiffer cables. This method reduces stress and preserves the cable's integrity.

Pulling and Lashing Fiber optic cables should be pulled by the strength members, not the jacket, unless approved by the manufacturer. Use swivel pulling eyes and approved grips (e.g., Kellems grips) to attach the cable to the pulling rope. For hand pulls, use 8mm polyester or polyaramid ropes; for winches, 12.5mm or thicker ropes are recommended. Avoid nylon or steel ropes, which can damage the cable or ducts.

Bend Radius and Tension Maintain the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer: typically 20 times the cable diameter under tension and 10 times without tension. Do not exceed the maximum pulling tension, and avoid sags,...
