Design Considerations

Structure: These trays may combine ladder, perforated, or solid-bottom designs depending on the type of cables and environmental conditions. Ladder-style rungs provide ventilation for power cables, while solid or perforated bottoms protect sensitive instrumentation or control cables.

Materials: Common materials include aluminum, galvanized steel, stainless steel, and fiber-reinforced plastics (FRP). Aluminum offers corrosion resistance and lightweight properties, while stainless steel provides high durability in harsh environments.

Cable Separation: Double-pass trays allow segregation of high-voltage and low-voltage cables, or power and data lines, reducing electromagnetic interference and improving safety.

Bend Radius and Support: Irregular layouts require careful attention to minimum bend radius for cables and proper support spacing to prevent sagging or damage. Rung spacing typically ranges from 150 to 230 mm (6–9 inches) for optimal cable support.
