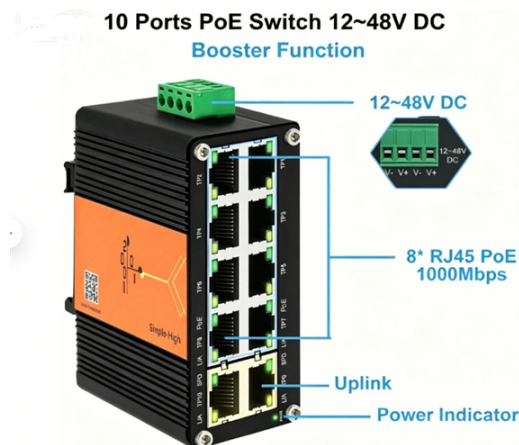


Is an SMC cable trough considered a cable tray

The trough cable tray is a fully enclosed cable tray.
