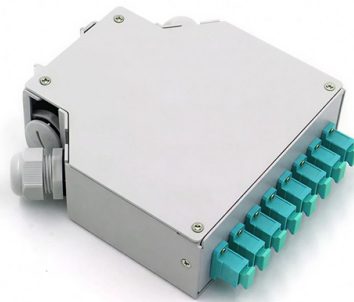


Is it okay to put cables in cable trays
