- Core Count:** Typically 1–4 fibers for residential FTTH, 2–12 fibers for multi-dwelling units or enterprise networks ().

- Round Drop Cables:** Provide superior crush resistance and waterproofing for duct or direct-burial applications ().
- Strength Members:** FRP or steel for tensile support; aramid yarn for crush resistance ().
