Designed to handle high-current surges from direct lightning strikes, with discharge currents ≥ 12.5 kA and maximum capacity ≥ 100 kA per phase. Voltage protection level is ≤ 2500 V. This level diverts most surge energy to the earth and protects the overall power system.
- Level 2 (Secondary Protection):** Installed at distribution equipment supplying sensitive or important devices. Absorbs residual surge energy after Level 1 protection, with maximum discharge capacity ≥ 40 kA per phase and voltage protection level ≤ 2000 V. This ensures normal operation of most electrical devices.
- Level 3 (Tertiary Protection):** Installed inside critical equipment or at the power input of sensitive electronics. Designed to eliminate micro transient overvoltages, with maximum discharge capacity around 20 kA per phase and voltage protection level ≤ 1800 V.
