Identification and Safety The panel is usually a rectangular metal box about the size of a medicine cabinet, with a door covering the circuit breakers. Look for:

- A metal door with a handle, sometimes labeled with "Main" or "Circuit Breaker."
- Electrical wiring or conduit leading to the box.

Clearance requirements: NEC standards require at least 30 inches of width and 3 feet of front workspace, with the highest breaker handle no more than 6 feet 7 inches above the floor.
