Conduit bending considerations: When wires are routed through conduits or junction boxes, ensure that bends comply with NEC regulations. The total angle of all bends between pull points should not exceed 360 degrees to prevent excessive strain on the wire insulation and facilitate easier pulling.

Multi-strand wires: More flexible and better suited for manual bending. The strands slide slightly during bending, reducing the risk of conductor damage.

Single-strand hard wires: Maintain their shape well after bending but require careful handling to avoid snapping or kin...
