

Methods for pressing cables in fire protection distribution boxes

Cables in fire protection distribution boxes are secured using cable glands, strain relief clamps, and firestop materials to ensure mechanical stability and maintain fire-rated integrity. Cable Securing Techniques

1. Cable Glands and Clamps Fire protection distribution boxes, such as the OBO FireBox, use V-TEC cable glands to provide secure torsion protection and strain relief across the entire clamping range. These glands are available in sizes M16 to M40 and are paired with locknuts to ensure a tight, stable connection of the cable to the box, preventing movement during normal operation or in the event of a fire .
2. Strain Relief and Torsion Protection Cables should be pressed or clamped in a way that prevents pulling, twisting, or bending at the entry point. The glands or collars distribute mechanical stress evenly, reducing the risk of conductor damage or insulation compromise. Proper pressing ensures that the cable remains in place even under thermal expansion or vibration conditions .
3. Firestop Materials To maintain the fire rating of the enclosure, openings around cables are sealed using intumescent caulks, moldable putty, or firestop pillows. For example, Eaton's IC 15WB caulk and 3M moldable pillows can be applied around cables to block heat penetration and contain fire and smoke, preserving the fire-resistance rating of the box .
4. Installation Procedure Insert the cable fully into the gland or clamp to the marked depth. Tighten the gland or collar according to manufacturer specifications to achieve proper compression. Apply firestop material around the cable if the box penetrates a fire-rated wall or ceiling. Verify that the cable is mechanically stable and that the firestop seal is continuous and intact .
5. Standards and Compliance Ensure that all pressing and clamping methods comply with local fire protection regulations and standards, such as E30, E60, or E90 maint...
