

Minimum size for fiber optic splice closures

- Large closures: 8-12 trays, 144-288 fibers or more

Closures for ribbon cables require special trays to maintain proper bend radius, while loose tube cables use standard trays with buffer tube management.

Environmental and Cable Considerations

When selecting a closure size, consider:

- Cable diameter and type:** Ensure ports and strain relief accommodate the cable sheath and strength members.
- Installation environment:** Buried, aerial, or manhole installations may require larger or more robust closures for environmental protection.
- Future expansion:** Leave 20-30% extra capacity in trays for network growth or additional splices.
