Multimode fiber optic modules use LC or MPO connectors to interface with OM3, OM4, or OM5 fibers, supporting short- to medium-range high-speed data transmission.

Overview of Multimode Fiber Modules Multimode fiber (MMF) modules are designed for short- to medium-distance optical communication, typically within buildings, campuses, or data centers. MMF has a larger core diameter (50–62.5 μm) than single-mode fiber, allowing multiple light modes to propagate simultaneously, which simplifies alignment and reduces cost for high-bandwidth applications. MMF supports data rates up to 100 Gbps over distances ranging from 100 meters to 550 meters, depending on fiber type (OM3, OM4, OM5) and transceiver specifications.

Common Module Types SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable): Compact, hot-pluggable modules used for 1G to 10G speeds, often with LC connectors for MMF. Standard MMF SFP modules operate at 850 nm and support short-range links, typically 100–550 meters. QSFP (Quad Small Form-factor Pluggable): High-density modules for 40G and 100G Ethernet. Multimode QSFP modules, such as 100GBASE-SR4-S, use MPO connectors and support parallel fiber links over OM3 (up to 70 m) and OM4 (up to 100 m). QSFP modules are ideal for data center backbone and high-performance computing networks.

Connector Interfaces LC (Lucent Connector): Most common for SFP modules, providing precise alignment for single or multimode fibers. MPO/MTP (Multi-fiber Push-On/Pull-off): Used in QSFP modules for high-density parallel fiber connections, typically 12 or 24 fibers per connector.

SC (Subscriber Connector): Mostly found in legacy networks; less common in modern MMF deployments.

Fiber Standards OM3: Laser-optimized MMF, supports 10G–100G Ethernet over distances up to 300 m (10G) and 70 m (100G QSFP) using VCSELs. OM4: Enhanced MMF, extends reach to 400 m (10G) and 100 m (100G QSFP) for high-speed links. OM5: Wideband MMF, designed for shortwave wavelength division multiplexing (SWDM), enabling m...
