

National Standard Galvanized Cable Tray Size Specifications Table



AI Overview

Galvanized cable trays are standardized according to NEMA VE 1/VE 2, NEC Article 392, and ASTM A653 for steel, with typical widths from 50mm to 600mm, heights from 25mm to 150mm, and thicknesses meeting corrosion-resistant requirements.

Material and Coating Standards Galvanized cable trays are primarily fabricated from steel sheets coated with zinc to prevent corrosion. Common standards include ASTM A123 for hot-dip zinc coatings, ASTM A653 for structural galvanized steel sheets, and ASTM B633 for electrodeposited zinc coatings. Standard Dimensions According to NEMA VE 1/VE 2 and NEC Article 392, standard galvanized cable tray dimensions are as follows:

- Widths:** Typically 50mm to 600mm, depending on cable volume and application.
- Heights (side rails):** 25mm to 150mm, selected based on cable fill and ventilation requirements.
- Thickness:** Varies by load rating; heavy-duty trays often require ≥ 2.5 mm thickness with reinforced side rails for maximum support.
- Lengths:** Standard straight sections are usually 3 meters, with bends, tees, and elbows available for routing.

Load Capacity and Design Considerations Tray load capacity increases with width, height, and material thickness. Proper sizing requires calculating the total cross-sectional area of cables, applying a fill ratio (typically 40-50%), and ensuring adequate ventilation to preven...
