 - TIA-568.3-D:** Covers optical fiber cabling for commercial buildings, including installation, testing, and performance requirements .
 - ISO/IEC 11801:** International standard for structured cabling systems, often referenced in national implementations.
- National Electrical Code (NEC)** The NEC, published by NFPA, regulates the installation of communications cables, including optical fiber, to ensure safety and compliance with electrical codes . Key points include:
 - Article 800:** General requirements for communications systems, consolidating cable installation rules.
 - Separation requirements:** Optical fiber cables must be separated from power, fire alarm, and medium-power circuits to prevent interference and hazards .
 - Limited-Power Cables:** Guidelines for low-hazard fiber optic cables used as substitutes for Cl...
