Network Cable Connectors

RJ45 Connectors Used for Ethernet cables (Cat5e, Cat6, Cat6a, Cat7). Features an 8P8C (8 positions, 8 contacts) modular plug. Supports twisted-pair copper cabling for data transmission. Commonly used in LANs, data centers, and office networks. Installation involves crimping the connector onto the cable with a proper tool to ensure reliable contact.

Other Copper Connectors

RJ11: Used for telephone lines.

GG45 or TERA: High-performance connectors for Cat7/Cat8 cables in specialized networks.

Fiber Optic Cable Connectors Fiber optic connectors are designed to align and join optical fibers, allowing light to pass with minimal loss. They are used in telecommunications, data centers, and enterprise networks. Key types include:

- SC (Subscriber Connector):** Square-shaped, push-pull mechanism, widely used in FTTH and data centers. Available in single-mode and multimode versions.
- LC (Lucent Connector):** Miniaturized version of SC with a 1.25mm ferrule, ideal for high-density applications. Uses a latch mechanism similar to RJ45.
- ST (Straight Tip):** Bayonet-style locking system, durable, often used in industrial or campus networks.
- FC (Flange Connector):** Threaded design for high precision and stability, used in instrumentation and long-distance networks.
- MPO/MTP:** Multi-fiber connectors for high-bandwidth applications, common in cloud computing and large-scale data centers.
- E2000:** Features a built-in shutter to protect the fiber end from dust, used in high-reliability telecom applications.
- MT-RJ:** Compact duplex connector for LANs, supporting both multimode and single-mode fibers.

Key Considerations for Fiber Connectors

- Insertion Loss:** The amount of signal lost when connecting fibers.
- Return Loss:** Reflected light back into the source; lower is better.
- Durability:** Some connectors are designed for rugged environments.
- Single-mode vs Multimode:** Single-mode fiber...
