Overview

Niger has taken a major step toward digital modernization with the provisional handover of more than 1,000 kilometers of fibre-optic cable, part of the Trans-Sahara Optical Fibre Backbone Project (TSB) financed by the African Development Bank Group. OPPC cables are primarily used in voltage levels below 110kV, such as suburban distribution networks and rural. OPPC serves as a specialized hybrid technology that integrates fiber optics directly into energized power lines, primarily in 35kV and 110kV networks where ground wires are absent. Dual purpose: live phase conductor and an optical path. Distribution or transmission – 36-245kV.
