Finishes may include powder coating, painted surfaces, or galvanization to extend service life and meet environmental requirements.

Dimensions and Types Cable trays are available in heights ranging from 25mm to 100mm, widths from 40mm to 1000mm, and standard lengths of 2500mm. Thicknesses typically range from 1.2mm to 3mm, depending on load requirements. Common types include:

- Ladder trays:** Suitable for heavy-duty power distribution, providing high strength and ventilation for heat dissipation.
- Perforated trays:** Allow airflow and are used for medium voltage or instrumentation cables.
- Solid-bottom trays:** Used where additional protection against dust, moisture, or electromagnetic interference is required.

Standards and Compliance Cable trays in North Africa generally comply with international and regional standards, including CE marking for European directives, NEMA standards in the USA, and ISO 9001 quality management certification for installation companies. High voltage installations are often fully type-tested systems, ensuring compatibility between cables and accessories, and adherence to safety and performance standards.
