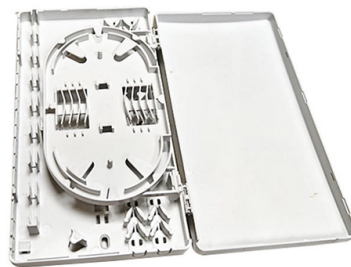

There is no universal limit; the maximum number of terminals is determined by the box's dimensions, terminal type, and safety standards.

Capacity per box can range from a few terminals in small residential boxes to dozens in industrial boxes with multiple terminal rails.
