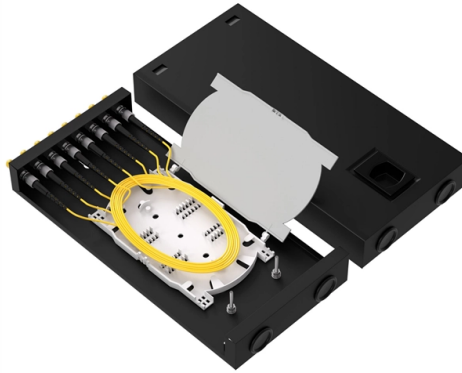

- Rack Space (U Height):** ODFs come in various heights (1U, 2U, 4U), so plan rack allocation according to fiber density and future expansion.
- Cable Management:** Ensure horizontal and vertical management paths are available to prevent excessive bending and maintain signal integrity.
- Environmental Protection:** Some ODFs include locking doors or covers to protect delicate splices from dust and physical damage, which is especially important in shared server rooms.
