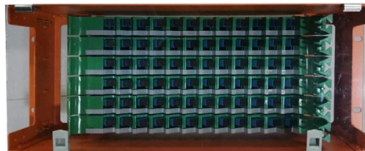


Optical module registration status 5



AI Overview

Status 5 in optical module registration typically corresponds to the “Operation” phase, where the ONU exchanges authentication information with the OLT to complete the registration process.

Understanding Optical Module Registration Status

In GPON networks, an ONU (Optical Network Unit) goes through several states to register with an OLT (Optical Line Terminal). The registration process generally includes:

- Standby (O2)** – The ONU receives initial configuration messages and adjusts its internal parameters.
- Serial Number Exchange (O3)** – The ONU sends its serial number to the OLT, which allocates a temporary ONU-ID.
- Ranging (O4)** – The OLT calculates the compensation delay for the ONU and communicates it back.
- Operation (O5)** – The ONU responds to a password request from the OLT and completes authentication. This is typically referred to as status 5.
- Intermittent LODS / Emergency Stop (O6/O7)** – These states indicate abnormal conditions or errors during registration.

. During status 5, the ONU is actively completing the authentication and management channel setup. Only after successfully passing this stage does the ONU go fully online and become manageable by the OLT.

Verifying and Troubleshooting Status 5

Check ONU Run State: Use the OLT command (e.g., `display ont info`) to verify if the ONU is online or still in registration. If the ONU remains in status 5 for an extended period, it may indicate authentication failure or configuration mismatch.

Password and Serial Number: Ensure the SN and password configured on the OLT match the ONU's actual credentials. Mismatches prevent the ONU from completing registration.

Optical Module Health: Verify that the SFP or optical module is certified, and that transmit/receive power levels are within normal ranges. Abnormal optical power can prevent successful registration.

Physical Layer Checks: Inspect fiber connections, replace faulty cables, and ensure the PON port laser is enabled. A faulty optical module or port can block the ONU from reaching status 5 completion.
