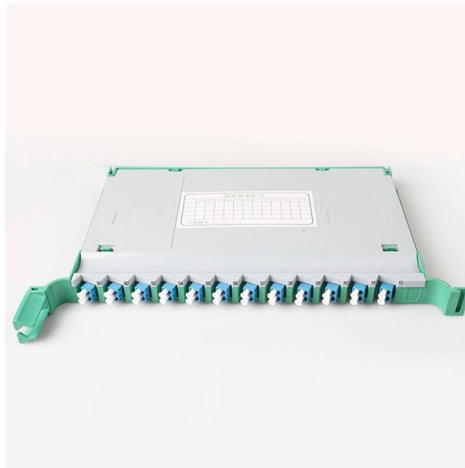


Outdoor Optical Cable Usage

Aerial Installations Aerial cables are deployed on poles or messenger wires and are designed to withstand wind, ice, and UV exposure. ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) cables are non-metallic and self-supporting, ideal for overhead power lines and areas with strong electromagnetic interference, allowing spans of 50–500 meters without additional support. OPGW (Optical Ground Wire) combines lightning protection with communication functions, suitable for high-voltage transmission lines above 66kV. These cables are commonly used in suburban or rural backbone networks.

Direct-Burial Applications Direct-buried cables are installed underground, often in challenging terrains like mountains or hilly areas. Reinforced armored cables (GYTA33) provide high tensile strength and lateral pressure resistance, making them suitable for long-term underground deployment. Rodent-resistant cables (GYTA53) use stainless steel tape armor to prevent gnawing and corrosion, ideal for farmland, forests, or areas with high rodent activity. These cables can be installed overhead, in conduits, or directly buried.

Duct Installations Cables installed in ducts are protected from environmental exposure and mechanical stress. GYTA and GYTS armored cables are commonly used in duct systems, offering water-blocking and UV-resistant polyethylene sheaths. Loose tube or ribbon fiber designs allow high fiber counts (2–144 fibers) and facilitate fast splicing and network expansion. Duct installations are typical in urban areas or retrofitted networks where space is constrained.
