Fill Limits: For power cables, the fill must not exceed 40% of the tray's. MicroDucts are small diameter conduits ranging from 5-22mm OD that provide a pathway for fiber cables. FuturePath is two or more MicroDucts bundled. Type TC-ER-JP tray cable has several main uses in a home: For interior wiring, the cable may be installed following the same requirements as NM-B (Romex), such as between framing members, through studs or above ceilings. NEC Article 334 governs proper support, securing and protection.
