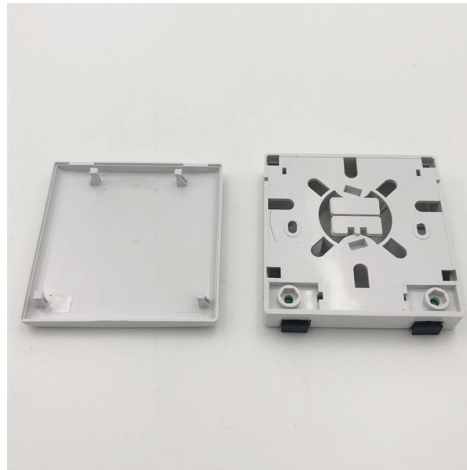


Placement of network security equipment on balcony
