

Plug a 10G optical module into a gigabit switch

Use a 1G SFP module in the 10G SFP+ port on the 10G switch (if the port supports 1G modules) to ensure the link operates at 1G. Verify the switch vendor documentation to confirm that the 10G SFP+ port supports 1G SFP modules, as some 10G ports only accept 10G SFP+ modules. Summary 10G SFP+ → 1G SFP port: Not compatible, link will not come up. 1G SFP → 10G SFP+ port: Compatible, link will operate at 1G. Always check switch specifications for dual-rate support if connecting different speeds. Using the correct module ensures reliable connectivity and avoids wasted network resources.
