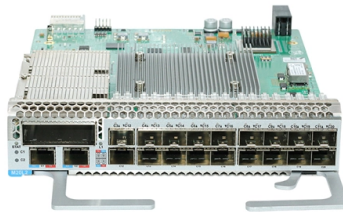


PoE Switch Overdistance Mode



AI Overview

PoE Switch Overdistance Mode, often called Extend or CCTV Mode, allows PoE transmission beyond the standard 100 meters, typically up to 250 meters, by reducing port speed and optimizing power delivery.

Overview Standard PoE transmission is limited to 100 meters (328 feet) due to voltage drop, signal degradation, and DC resistance in Ethernet cables. Overdistance modes, such as Extend Mode or CCTV Mode, are designed to overcome this limitation by lowering the port speed (usually to 10 Mbps) and adjusting power output, enabling devices like IP cameras or access points to operate at longer distances without additional power sources.

How It Works

Port Speed Reduction: In Extend Mode, the switch reduces the port speed to 10 Mbps, which decreases signal interference and allows power to travel further along the cable.

Power Management: The switch ensures sufficient PoE power is delivered to the device, but the maximum number of devices per extended port is often limited (e.g., two devices on TL-SG1005P ports 1-2).

Distance Limit: Typical extended distances reach 250 meters, though actual performance depends on cable quality, device power consumption, and cable type.

Configuration Steps

For a managed PoE switch: Power on the switch and log in to the management interface. Locate the Extend Mode toggle or enable it via the controller interface (for example, in TL-SG1005P, ports 1-2 support this mode). Enable Extend Mode and confirm the port speed is set to 10 Mbps. Connect the powered devices, ensuring the total power consumption does not exceed the switch's extended port capacity. For unmanaged switches, the mode is usually enabled via a physical toggle or switch on the device.

Practical Considerations

Device Compatibility: Only devices that can operate at 10 Mbps and within the PoE power budget will function reliably at extended distances.

Cable Quality: High-quality cables (Cat 5e or higher) reduce voltage drop and signal loss, improving reliability.
