A PoE port is an Ethernet port on a PoE switch that delivers both data and electrical power to connected devices over a single cable. What is a PoE Port? A PoE (Power over Ethernet) port is a network port on a PoE switch that functions as Power Sourcing Equipment (PSE). It can transmit both network data and electrical power through a standard RJ45 Ethernet cable to compatible devices, known as Powered Devices (PDs), such as IP cameras, VoIP phones, wireless access points, and some IoT devices. This eliminates the need for separate power cables, simplifying installation and reducing wiring costs. Power Standards and Delivery PoE ports follow specific IEEE standards that define the amount of power they can supply: IEEE 802.3af (PoE): Delivers up to 15.4 W per port, suitable for low-power devices like IP phones and basic cameras. IEEE 802.3at (PoE+): Provides up to 30 W per port, supporting higher-power devices such as PTZ cameras and Wi-Fi 6 access points. IEEE 802.3bt (PoE++ or 4PPoE): Can deliver up to 60–90 W per port by using all four pairs of wires in the Ethernet cable, enabling power-hungry devices like LED lighting or advanced network equipment. The PoE budget of a switch determines the total power available across all PoE ports, so administrators must ensure the combined power requirements of connected devices do not exceed the switch's capacity. Functionality and Features Detection and Negotiation: When a device is connected, the PoE port detects if it is PoE-compatible and negotiates the required power level. Data Transmission: Simultaneously, the port transmits standard Ethernet data at speeds ranging from Fast Ethernet (100 Mbps) to Gigabit Ethernet (1000 Mbps). Port Types: PoE switches can have varying numbers of PoE ports, commonly 4, 8, 16, 24, or 48 ports, depending on network size and deployment needs. Uplink Ports: Some switches include uplink ports for connecting to routers or other switches; these ports typically do not provide power and are used for data only.
