

PoE switch power supply is far away

Factors Affecting PoE Distance

Cable Quality: High-quality Cat6 or Cat6a cables with low resistance reduce voltage drop and signal loss, allowing more stable PoE delivery over longer distances. Lower-quality cables or thin conductors (e.g., 26AWG) increase resistance and reduce effective distance.

Power Requirements: Devices requiring higher power (e.g., PoE++ Type 3 or 4) experience greater voltage drop, which can shorten the usable distance below 100 meters.

Environmental Conditions: High temperatures can increase cable resistance, further reducing effective PoE distance.

Switch Performance: Low-end switches may lack sufficient power management, limiting the ability to maintain stable PoE over long runs.

Solutions for Long-Distance PoE

PoE Extenders/Repeaters: These devices can be placed along the cable run to re-amplify power and data, effectively extending the distance by approximately 100 meters per extender.

Segmented Power Supply: Deploy multiple PoE switches or relays in series, each covering a 100-meter segment, to reach devices located far from the main switch.

Fiber Optic with PoE Conversion: Convert the Ethernet signal to fiber for long-distance transmission, then use a PoE injector or PoE switch at the far end to power devices. This method can extend distances to several kilometers while maintaining stable power and data delivery.

Deploy Switch Near Devices: If feasible, place a PoE switch closer to the powered d...
