### Pole and Route Planning

Before installation, a detailed design and survey is required:

- Survey the route and assess terrain, existing utilities, and obstacles ( ).**
- Determine pole spacing:** urban areas typically use 25–40 meters, suburban/rural areas 40–50 meters, and extreme environments up to 67 meters with reinforced poles ( ).
- Identify splice points and slack storage locations.**
- Obtain permits from local authorities and coordinate with traffic, police, and utility companies ( ).** Existing poles must be “made ready” by the owner, and permission is required to attach cables to existing infrastructure ( ).

### Installation and Safety

Aerial installation involves working at heights using ladders, bucket trucks, or climbing poles. Safety is critical: Workers must wear hardhats, gloves, protective clothing, steel-toed boots, and safety harnesses ( ). Maintain three-point contact wh...
