This method is typically used for low-power applications in remote, hazardous, or interference-sensitive environments, such as aerospace, deep-sea research, or high-voltage areas. PoF systems rely on photovoltaic cells to convert the optical energy into electricity, and the transmitted power is generally limited to a few watts or tens of watts, far below the levels handled by conventional power lines. Key Limitations Efficiency: Converting light to electricity involves losses, making PoF less efficient than copper or aluminum conductors for large-scale power transmission. Scale: Fiber optics cannot replace high-voltage transmission lines for delivering electricity over long distances due to power limitations and the need for large photovoltaic receivers.
