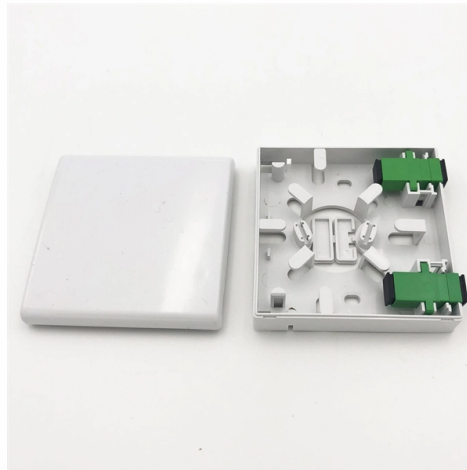


Quota for Opening Holes in Distribution Box Walls



Overview

Openings around boxes in noncombustible surfaces must not exceed $\frac{1}{4}$ inch to prevent fire spread. Boxes must be securely fastened to the structure using approved methods such as: Boxes must remain rigid and protected from physical damage. NEC Article 314 establishes requirements for the installation and use of electrical boxes, conduit bodies, fittings, and handhole enclosures.
