When an alarm is triggered, the operator must be able to identify the cause of the alarm and determine if the alarm is relevant. Modern field devices are able to generate a multitude of diagnostic messages, many of which are issued as alarms. Proper alarm management allows operators to quickly respond to faults, minimize downtime, and optimize system performance. Alarms indicate events and states on the HMI device which have occurred in the system, in the process or on the HMI device itself. A status is reported when it is received. An alarm could trigger one of the following alarm events: The configuration engineer defines which alarms must be acknowledged. The alarm system integrated in TwinCAT PLC Control allows detecting critical process states, recording them and visualizing them for the user with the aid of a visualization element. The alarm handling can be done in TwinCAT PLC Control or alternatively in the PLC.
