- Insert the module gently until it clicks into place; do not force it.
- Connect the appropriate cable (fiber or copper) carefully, avoiding bending or stressing fiber strands.
- Power on the device and check the LED indicators; a green light usually confirms a successful link.

Removal Steps

- Power off the device if hot-swapping is not supported.
- Release the latch (bail clasp or slide tab) on the SFP module.
